# 29th Anniversary of CBROA

Today we are celebrating the 29th anniversary of our beloved Canara Bank Retired Officers' Association. Thanks to the initiative of Sri. Sudhakar Shetty, the then General Secretary of CBOA who felt the need for a separate forum for retirees, our CBROA came into existence on 6th February 1996. It is not just a random date on the calendar. It represents a significant chapter in the history of CBROA. It marks the years of dedication, hard work, and commitment that have gone into shaping our association into what it is today. Today our cumulative membership crossed more than 15000 and our active membership stood at 12443. Our Associate membership is set to cross 4000.

I was elected as the General Secretary of this great organisation during our Biennial conference held at Mysore in April 2023. Since then, we have been working to give a new impetus to our beloved CBROA to make it more stronger and more responsive to the aspirations of our members. Couple of issues of retirees which our Association was fighting for several years has been resolved during the last two years. 100% DA neutralisation for pre-November 2002 was achieved during October 2023. Pension option for resignees was achieved during June 2024. Ex-gratia amount was paid to the retirees pending pension updation since March 2024. The more burning issue of affordable medical insurance scheme was achieved during October 2024. However, our main issue of Pension updation is still eluding us and we are confident and hopeful of achieving the same during the current year.

On the organisational front, we have been constantly striving to streamline the working of CBROA and very happy to inform our members that our austerity measures and digital initiatives are yielding results and strengthening our CBROA financially as well as making it a more responsive and visible association among the comity of retirees associations.

Some of our initiatives to consolidate our position and help our members are:

1. Subscribing to Super top up policy offered by K M Dastur in 2023 and also in 2024, which has helped around 2000 members and their families to have an affordable medical insurance scheme over and above the IBA's base policy of Rs.4 lakhs.
2. Achieved substantial improvements in medical reimbursement to retirees under staff welfare measures during the last 2years. Rs 6000/- to retirees opting for IBA's Group Medical insurance scheme and Rs 4000/- to all others.
3. For the first time, all our family pensioners are getting medical reimbursement amount on par with regular pensioners.
4. Instrumental in introducing cremation expenses of Rs. 10000/- to retirees under staff welfare measures.
5. Extending 50% concession on locker rent to all the retirees including family pensioners.
6. Taking several issues of our members in Grievance redressal meetings especially for the smooth settlement of claims under IBA's group medical insurance scheme.

On organisational front, we have developed our website free of cost and it is now very user friendly and mobile compatible and all the relevant information about our

association, Bank and industry can be accessed. We have also created Community concept in WhatsApp groups across the country and all the relevant information from the association like - circulars, birth day greetings, GS messages etc., are posted in Announcement group so that our members can access the same at their leisure time, without the fear of losing any information amidst the thousands of other messages in the general groups. A separate centralised group for family pensioners is also created. We have digitalised all our operations and issuing e-receipts for all life membership associate membership and donations which resulted in huge savings on stationery, postage besides eliminating humongous manual work. We are planning to introduce a membership module in our website.

Our Association is having a unique medical reimbursement scheme. We are the only retiree's association which is having such a scheme. Thanks to the kind hearted members, we have created a robust Welfare corpus of one crore plus and we intend to fund our reimbursement of hospitalisation expenses scheme from the income generated out of this fund.

We have negotiated with the world renown M/s Jayadeva Cardiovascular Hospital, Bengaluru and they are offering our Bank retirees an affordable and comprehensive health package at just Rs.2000/- for both the retiree and his spouse since September 2023. We have been conducting regular meetings across various regions in the country not only to discuss various issues of our members but also using the occasion to felicitate our members who are attaining the age of 75/90 years.

Friends, we have been maintaining a cordial relationship with our parent organisation CBOA and place on record the positive role played by their GS Sri K Ravikumar in clinching an affordable medical insurance scheme and other benefits under staff welfare measures.

To end with, while celebrating our 29th year of our existence, I recall the contributions made by all the former office bearers of CBROA who toiled hard to build this organisation which is today a vibrant, robust and thriving body of Canara Bank retired officers. I also thank all our central committee members and activists for extending their support, time and energy for smooth conduct of all the activities and making our CBROA a strong and vibrant entity. I believe, to build any organisation, team work is very important. We need to build a strong and vibrant team to take care of our beloved CBROA. In this connection, I request our members, activists, well-wishers to come forward to work and help us to build a formidable organisation.

### **CBROA Welfare Schemes: (Effective from 29.11.2024)**

#### **I. Medical Relief Scheme (Reimbursement of Hospitalization Expenses):**

##### **Objective:**

To assist the member/spouse by way of reimbursement of Hospitalization expenses for any ailment /disease /accident to the member or his /her spouse.

##### **Eligibility:**

All the life members are eligible for the scheme. The benefit of the scheme will be **available one year after** becoming a life member of the Association.

##### **Other Provisions:**

1. Maximum limit for each member is **Rs.30000/-** during his/her lifetime (a sub-limit of **Rs.10,000/-** would be made available for the spouse of the member, **provided he/she is our associate member.**
2. **Minimum** hospitalization expenses incurred must be **Rs 3, 00,000/- (Rs Three Lakhs only)** under **single hospitalization bill concept**. Investigation / Medicine expenses incurred pre and post hospitalisation (**up to 30 days** respectively) will be considered as hospitalization expenses for reimbursement purposes. However, in case of critical illness, viz. cancer and kidney ailment, since the treatment is for a longer period, treatment expenses incurred up to **one year** (post hospitalization) may be consolidated and claimed for the purpose of reimbursement.
3. CBROA will reimburse **75% of the disallowed portion** over and above the hospitalisation bill of **Rs.3 lakhs and above** (per hospitalisation bill) subject to a **minimum reimbursement of Rs.7500/-** in respect of members and **Rs.5000/-** in respect of spouses of members.
4. Members may prefer any number of claims during his/her lifetime, including claim for his/her spouse, subject to the overall limit of Rs.30000/-
5. In respect of members who are not covered under any insurance scheme, but claiming the amount from CBROA, reimbursement will be made at **50%** of the amount over and above the minimum hospitalisation bill of **Rs.3 lakhs**, subject to a **minimum reimbursement of Rs.7500/-** in respect of members **and Rs.5000/-** in respect of spouses of members.
6. Hospitalisation claims from CBROA shall be made within a reasonable period of **2 months** after discharge from the hospital.

Members claiming the reimbursement of Hospital expenses must submit the claim form to CBROA, Bengaluru office along with xerox copies of hospitalization / medicine bills & discharge summary.

#### **II. Honoring of Members who have attained the age of 75+,90+.100+ years:**

Members who have attained the age of 75+ years, 90+ years and 100+ years will be honored at Biennial Conference/various meetings conducted at different cities/places. In case the members are unable to attend such conferences or meetings, our office bearers/activists will call on such members at their residences to felicitate them.

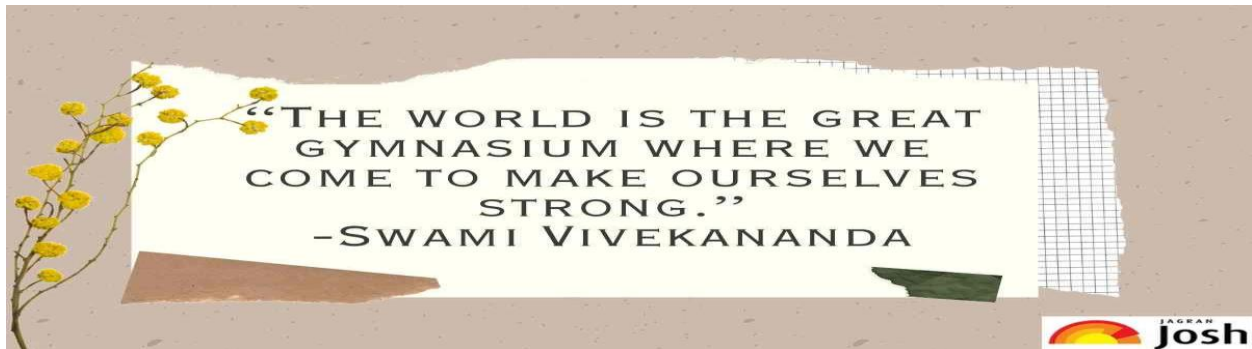

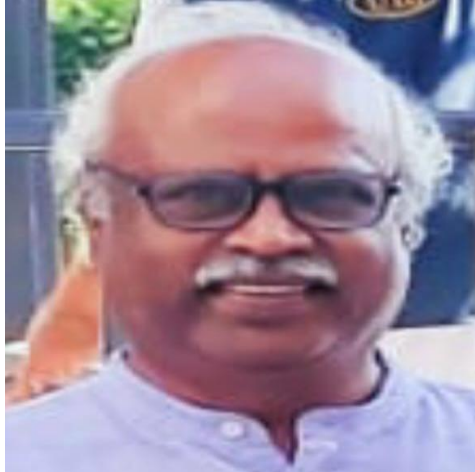

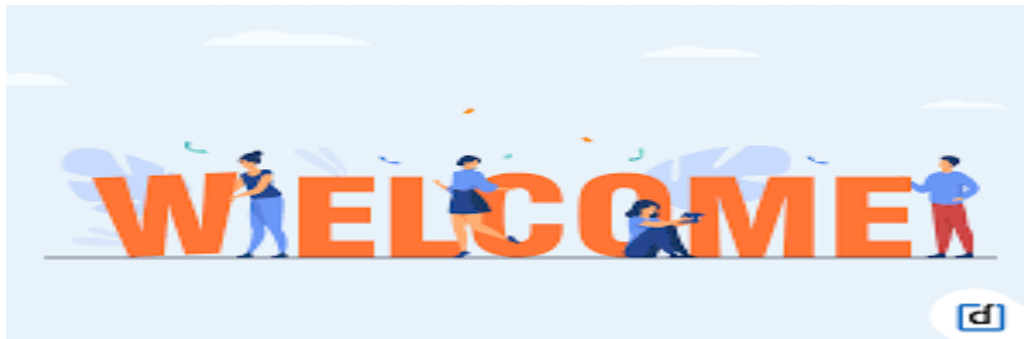
