


## FROM THE DESK OF GENERAL SECRETARY



**Dear Members/Associate Members,**

### THREE DECADES OF CBROA'S FRUITFUL AND MEANINGFUL JOURNEY.

6th February 1996 to now, thirty years of progress of CBROA is a testament to the collective strength of retired Officers of our Bank. Today marks a monumental milestone - 30 years of fighting for dignity, justice and legitimate rights of retired Officers of our Bank.

Thirty years ago Canara Bank Retired Officers' Association was born out of a necessity for the retired Officers to stand together to fight for dignity and securing legitimate rights. Today we celebrate three decades of solidarity, resilience and unwavering dedication to the cause of retired Officers of our Bank. During this journey we have navigated hard times, secured fair benefits and fought for the dignity of retired Officers.

To those who laid the foundation thirty years ago - Sri.Sudhakar Shetty, then General Secretary of CBOA, Late Sri P Sanjeeva Rao, Late Sri H S Gajanana Rao, Late Sri M N Sundaram. Sri.V Seetharamu paved the way for consolidation of retired Officers in our Bank under the banner of CBROA - thanks to them.

The Office bearers who carried the mantle of the organisation subsequently worked relentlessly to consolidate the retired Officers, pan India, and made the organisation a pillar of strength. Today we are a formidable force of more than 15,800 Members and more than 5000 Associate Members.

CBROA became the only hope of retired Officers of our Bank as the leadership fought for fairness, dignity and securing our legitimate rights. We took up the issues of retired Officers in particular and those of retirees in general, with the Management of our Bank and we achieved the following.

1. Because of our continuous follow up, Bank set up Retirees' Grievances Redressal Cell, a forum for addressing the issues of retirees. Our Bank was the first bank to set up the forum. Our Bank is holding the Grievances Redressal Cell Meetings very religiously once in six months, right from September 2010. We have utilised the forum effectively to redress the grievances of retirees.

2.We were able to get medical expenses reimbursement - initially it was Rs.500/- and today the amount reimbursed by the Bank is Rs.6,200/- for those who have subscribed to the IBA Group Mediclaim Policy and Rs.4,200/- for those who have not subscribed to the above policy.

We prevailed upon our Management to cover both the serving Employees and retirees jointly in the IBA Group Mediclaim Policy and this has resulted in substantial reduction in the premium amount for the retirees. Thanks to our MD & CEO Sri Sathya Narayana Raju who prevailed upon IBA to float the Group Mediclaim Policy covering both serving Employees and retirees. This facility has been implemented in all the Banks.

3.Due to our persistent follow up with the Management, we were able to get the medical expenses reimbursement to family pensioners also.

4.The Management agreed to our suggestion that every retiree should be given an Identity Card, a laminated Pension Payment Order.

5.Those who retired prior to 01.01.1986 were not eligible for pension and they were getting a small amount of monthly ex-gratia as per Government Orders.

We prevailed upon our Management to give additional amount from the Welfare Corpus, thus giving substantial relief to this category of retirees. The benefit was also extended to the families of such retirees.

6. Our Office bearers defended many charge sheeted Officers very effectively and saved such Officers from harsh punishments.

At the industry level, we spear headed the campaign for formation of All India Bank Pensioners and Retirees Confederation (AIBPARC) and have been an affiliate of AIBPARC since its foundation in 2012. CBROA is the largest constituent of AIBPARC and the President and General Secretary of our Organisation are adorning top positions in AIBPARC. Due to relentless campaign launched by AIBPARC, we could accomplish the following benefits for the pensioners and retirees of Banking Industry.

- (a) 100% D A Neutralisation to those who retired prior to 01.11.2002. This brought a big relief to this category of retirees.
- (b) Improvement in family pension from 15% of the last drawn pay of the employee to 30%. This brought substantial relief to the family pensioners who, hitherto were getting a pittance of pension.
- (c) Pension to those who had resigned from the service of the Bank after completing qualifying service of 20 years and above. This is a significant achievement as the Bank Employees' Pension Regulations 1995 had denied pension to this category of retirees.
- (d) Adding 5 years' notional service weightage to those retirees who had joined the service of the Bank as Specialist Officers after practicing in their respective fields and Bank had relaxed the maximum age criteria keeping in view their practical experience.
- (e) Improvement in Ex-gratia payment to those who retired prior to 01.01.1986.

These measures have brought immense relief to the pensioners and retirees. Our Apex Body AIBPARC is relentlessly campaigning for clinching the following long pending legitimate benefits which are hanging fire for the last more than 30 years.

- (i) Regular Updation of Basic Pension along with every new wage revision Bipartite Settlements and Joint Notes signed by Associations and Unions.
- (ii) Inclusion of Special Allowance introduced in the 10th Bipartite Settlement for pension fixation.
- (iii) Introduction of a comprehensive Mediclaim Policy for all the retirees and family pensioners, with premium cost to be borne by the Bank, in conformity with the Guidelines issued by the Government of India in February 2012. Or

formation of Health Scheme for all the Bank Retirees and Family pensioners on the line of Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS).

(iv) Increase in Welfare Benefits extended to pensioners / retirees.

We in CBROA finding that the IBA Group Medclaim Policy is insufficient to meet Medical emergencies, took the help of M/s.K M Dastur, Medclaim reinsurer, in evolving a Group Medclaim Policy with leading Insurance Companies. We could obtain a Group Medclaim Top Up Policy from SBI General Insurance Co. during the year 2023-24 covering Members of our Association at very affordable premium amount. During the year 2024-25, we obtained a Group Medclaim Top Up Policy from GO DIGIT Health Insurers at a very affordable premium amount. During the current year we have obtained a Top Up policy from SBI General Insurance Co. This has given a very comfortable health security to our Members.

The above accomplishments prove that we have built a legacy of strength and we. continue to fight for fairness because in union there is strength and we are proud to be part of this legacy. Thanks to all our members - past and present, who made this milestone possible. We are also proud to walk this path with all of you and let us keep making history together. We are not resting on our old laurels and our campaign to bring relief, comfort, joy and happiness to all our members continues unabated.

**Dear friends,**





But truth reveals a different tale to share.




## LISTENING HEARTS

## **FIRST LOAN, LASTING IMPRESSION.**

The big wall clock in the banking hall struck Two in the afternoon. I cleared my table of all papers and opened my lunch box. Even before I could dip my fingers into it, a voice at the door of my chambers interrupted me. I turned to see the source. An old man with salt pepper beard, a wrinkled and unshaven face was begging for my attention. Even before I could ask what was the matter, he folded his hands saying, “ondu upakaara maadu buddhi” in Tamil accented Kannada, meaning “Oh my Lord please do me a favour”. Looking at his disturbed face I enquired what he wanted to say. Chinnatambi had migrated from Tamil Nadu as a labourer in constructing a lake near a village in our branch command area. After completion of lake, he chose to stay back and took to fishing in that lake for his living. Everything went on smoothly until one day his main asset, the fishing net was stolen by someone. He was distraught having lost his fishing net. He was in need of about Rs.1500 to buy a new fishing net. He was desperate having no means to buy a new fishing net. He had approached our Bank with great hope for help. His voice and body language suggested that his request was genuine.


A presanction visit was made the following day. His was a modest thatched house over looking the lake where he used to go for fishing. After due process, a loan of Rs.1500 under Differential Interest Rate scheme (D I R @4 %) was disbursed to him. He profusely thanked with folded hands to all of us in the Branch before leaving.

After a couple of days on a routine visit to his Village, I visited his house to see his new fishing net, a post sanction visit. I was in for a shock. There was a new occupant in his House! On enquiry I was informed that Chinnatambi had left the village for good and went to Tamil Nadu to spend rest of his life. I remembered his visit and his apparently innocent face begging for help. “Oh it

was all a cunning act!", so I thought. This episode lingered in my mind for many days as it was the first loan I had sanctioned as Branch head.

A few months passed on. I was busy with Branch affairs and this episode had almost faded away from my mind. One day there was a Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due. It was from Chinnatambi! from a remote place in Tamilnadu! Growing curious I opened the cover and lo! There was a letter written in English on behalf of Chinnatambi. It stated that his sons had urged him return to Tamilnadu to live with them. He profusely apologized for leaving without informing us. What was more surprising was that he had sent a Demand Draft for Rs.1600 towards repayment of D I R Loan! Rs.1500 with interest of about Rs.15 for three months was all that needed to close the Loan. The balance was promptly sent back to him and this time thanking profusely was our turn!

(This is a real story of 1987 in SALUR branch Karnataka. The Loan was processed by none other than our active member Sri P. M. Shanbhag who was my colleague then. This anecdote was carried out in one of the issues of Shreyas house magazine)






