DELEGATE SESSION ON 22.03.2026.

The Delegate Session was given a flying start with the presence of two stalwarts of Officers' Trade Union movement and Pensioners in the Banking Industry, Sri Suprita Sarkar, General Secretary, AIBPARC and Sri G D Nadaf, General Secretary, SBI Pensioners' Federation.

Sri Suprita Sarkar, explained about the consistent campaign launched by AIBPARC in redressing the legitimate aspirations of the pensioners and family pensioners of Banking Industry. Condemning the dubious, illegal approach of IBA and the Government in settling the long pending issue of Pension Updation, he asserted that no force on earth can stall the updation of Pension and AIBPARC will leave no stone unturned to clinch the issue and bring relief, solace and comfort to the pensioners and family pensioners. He stressed the need for consolidation of all Bank Pensioners under the banner of AIBPARC and gave a call for standing unitedly with AIBPARC in all its endeavours. He wished the Delegate Session all success.

Sri.G D Nadaf, in his inimitable style explained as to how the second option for pension was clinched with the intervention of the then Union Finance Minister Sri Pranav Mukherjee. He asserted that other issues including Updation of Pension, also will be settled very soon bringing lot of relief to the pensioners and family pensioners.

Presiding over the Delegate Session, Sri. A N Krishna Murthy, directed the General Secretary to present his report. The General Secretary presented his report and read important part of the report. The General Secretary had sent the Report by Email to all the Central Committee Members and also to the Delegates and as majority of the Central Committee Members had given their approval for the report, there were very few participants who participated in the deliberations on the report of the General Secretary. The General Secretary offered clarifications on the queries raised by the delegates on the Report. The General Secretary's Report was unanimously approved/adopted by the house.

The Delegate Session also unanimously approved the Financial Statements for the years 2023-24, 2024-25 and Receipts & Payments Statement from 01.04.2025 to 20.03.2026.

The Official Resolutions on Updation of Pension, Inclusion of Special Allowance for arriving at Basic Pension and Gratuity, Restoration of commuted pension within 10 years and 8 months, Introduction of affordable Health Insurance Scheme for the retired employees on the lines of Central Government's CGHS, Waiver of GST on Health Insurance Policy, Setting up Grievances Redressal Forum at the Circle level and also Regional Office level , Keeping Medical Expenses reimbursement costs out of Staff Welfare Measures, Permitting Preferential Rate of interest on Deposits of the Employees in case of Joint Deposits where the retiree is not number one Depositor, Restoration of Commutation on completion of 11-12 years where differential commutation is paid to the retiree on account of wage revision etc., were unanimously passed.

Sri A N Krishna Murthy, President, in his presidential address summarised the day's proceedings and expressed his happiness over smooth conduct of the proceedings. He eulogised the hard efforts put in by the Reception Committee under the leadership of Sri.D Vijay Kumar, that led to the grand success of the Conference. He placed on record the pains taking efforts of the members of the functional Committees, volunteers who have struggled for the last 6 months to put everything in place in a spic and span manner. Every Delegate, observers, Invitees highly appreciated the beautiful arrangements made by the Reception Committee, especially the tasty food served caught the imagination of all. Kudos to the team.

He thanked the delegates, observers, Invitees for their disciplined conduct and enthusiastic participation.

He dissolved the current Central Committee and paved the way for election of New set of Office bearers for the ensuing Triennial period. The list of newly elected Office bearers is furnished separately.

Friends, the Conference ended on a very happy note. Our delegates, observers and Invitees have returned to their destinations with the CBROA spirit enlivened in their heart and sweet memories of the Conference.

AIBPARC NEWS

KARNATAKA STATE

On 23rd of March our President Sri A N Krishnamurthy and General secretary Sri J S Jagadeesh along with a few of our Office Bearers and Sri R M Joshi, our former Vice President, attended the special meeting called by AIBPARC at Bengaluru to discuss about the amendments and arrangements to be made for the ensuing Triennial at Ernakulam.

President and GS of AIBPARC, Sri K V Acharya and Sri Suprita Sarkar, respectively, congratulated our President and GS on their re-election and offered them a floral bouquet .

WEST BENGAL STATE

The meeting of the State Committee of AIBPARC, West Bengal was held on 5th March 2026 at Kolkata from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM. The meeting was presided over by the State President, Sri Tridib Bhattacharya. A total of 49 State Committee members attended the meeting.

In his presidential address, Sri Bhattacharya spoke about the prevailing global situation and the crisis emerging in the world economy. He observed that certain power-driven and aggressive leaders are creating tensions in order to overcome their own economic difficulties and compel other countries to open their markets or submit to their dominance. He cautioned that in such circumstances the working class and pensioners are likely to be the most affected sections of society. He therefore called upon members to remain united and vigilant against such developments.

The meeting was then addressed by Sri Suprita Sarkar, All India General Secretary, AIBPARC. He briefed the members on the current status of the pension updation case, informing that the final hearing is scheduled on 12th March 2026. He stated that eminent senior advocates have been engaged and assured the members that financial resources are not a constraint for pursuing the case. He also mentioned that the legal position appears to be in favour of the pensioners and that the observations of the learned judges have so far been encouraging. However, he advised members not to become over-enthusiastic at this stage and strictly cautioned them against posting comments on social media or writing to any lawyers or judges regarding the matter. He also informed the house that the GST-related case pending before the Kerala High Court, which was scheduled to be heard on 8th March, has been adjourned.

During the deliberations, representatives from the retiree organisations of different affiliated banks participated, with one representative from each bank presenting their views. The discussions mainly focused on issues relating to the IBA Medical Insurance Policy, including subsidy on insurance premium, PPN (Preferred Provider Network) agreements between insurance companies and hospitals with capped treatment packages for different ailments, and the status of the Special Allowance case pending before the court. Organisational issues relating to the amalgamation of Regional Rural Banks (Gramin Banks) were also discussed.

From Canara Bank, Sri Swapan Haldar, State Committee Member of AIBPARC, participated in the discussion and shared his views on these matters.

Replying to the points raised during the deliberations, the General Secretary addressed all the issues in detail. Regarding the IBA Medical Insurance Policy, he clarified that members will have to avail treatment within the caps fixed under the PPN agreements, and if any member opts for a higher package, the additional amount will have to be borne personally. On the matter of the Special Allowance case, he informed the members that 14 different cases have been clubbed and referred to a single bench. He explained that coordinating among various parties involved in the case is a Herculean task. It has therefore been decided that AIBPARC will file a separate case in the same court, which will automatically make the organisation a party to the proceedings. However, the filing of this case will be taken up after the conclusion of the pension updation case pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Regarding the amalgamation and reorganisation of different Gramin Bank retiree associations, the General Secretary clarified that AIBPARC will not interfere in the internal organisational matters of those associations and that they will have to resolve their issues independently.

The meeting concluded after detailed discussions on the agenda and organisational matters.



MESSAGE FROM GS SRI J S JAGADEESH ON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF OUR TRIENNIAL CONFERENCE @ BENGALURU ON 21ST & 22ND MARCH 2026'

Dear friends,

I wanted to come out with a detailed circular on the proceedings of the 13th Triennial conference soon after the Triennial. However, immediately after the conference on 22nd, I had to attend AIBPARC core committee meeting on 23rd and today attended the Grievance redressal meeting at Head office and tomorrow I have to go to Mysore to participate in the inaugural function of CBOA holiday home. Hence, this message before it gets late!

Friends, I am receiving hundreds of messages and calls on the successful completion of the 13th Triennial conference of our beloved CBROA coinciding with the 30th year of its existence. Though we started planning for our Conference 6 months earlier, the ongoing shortage of LPG due to US-Iran war has put a question mark over the smooth conduct of the conference! We were nervous and anxious for the last few days since there was no sign of availability of commercial LPG cylinders! Though our caterer arranged for fire wood, it would be a herculean task to prepare the food for thousands of people with only fire wood! However, we approached the Minister of food supplies and other Govt, officials and arranged sufficient commercial LPG cylinders just before the event on 20th March!

Friends, at the end, everything fell in place and the 13th Triennial Conference has created a new bench mark and a history of sorts in the annals of CBROA!. A record 2300 plus members attended the conference both on the inaugural day on 21st and Delegates session on 22nd March which is unprecedented and broke all the earlier records! though we were expecting around 1800-2000 members since only 1560 members registered as delegates!

Friends, for success of any conference of such a magnitude, the most important factor is serving of good food and satisfying the palates of the members attending the conference! Yes, the overwhelming response of the members was positive and members were unanimous in praising the quality, taste and variety of food served on both the days! The entire credit goes to our caterers Mr. Jayaram Shetty of Vinayaka canteen. He managed the unprecedented crowd so well and handled the situation with enormous patience as there were more than 300- 500 persons over our estimate! who thronged the conference!The entire proceedings went so smoothly starting from inaugural session, flawless registration of 1600 plus delegates providing them with a kit of GS report and a T shirt of their choice! within a short time of 2 hours! on 22nd morning.

The inaugural session went on very well with a witty and humorous speech by Padmashree Dr C N Manjunath followed by wonderful speech by our beloved ED Sri S K Majumdar and an emotional and thundering speech by Sri K V Acharya, the President of AIBPARC. KOLKATA

Members of CBOA and CBROA under the banner of PRAYAS a Social Organization never hesitate to extend hands beyond boundaries. Sunday, the 8th of March team PRAYAS went to Oncolink Palliative Care Hospital, located about 65 KMs from Kolkata. The 4 bigha campus is situated within 10 minutes of drive from Madanpur railway station, among pristine rural area in village Teghari in Nadia district, West Bengal. This hospital is the brainchild of Dr. Amit Sarkar, who is also an ex-Canarite. It all started about 30 years ago, with the original aim to provide free or affordable access to cancer treatment for the needy poor, especially from far flung rural areas. With the help from likeminded doctors and other people, free cancer clinics were started at Kolkata.

However, soon this initiative expanded to cover counselling for the terminally ill patients and their families, which was more important than the medicines. This led to the search for palliative care for the terminally ill, whose family cannot afford the hospital cost. The Madanpur Centre of Oncolink takes care of providing treatment, therapy as well as terminal medical care for the patients, with dignity and care, all at a very nominal cost. The Madanpur Centre presently have two wards (male and female), with a sanctioned capacity of 10 beds in each ward, totaling 20 beds. There are doctor's chambers, chemotherapy and other facilities, training and meeting rooms as well as a full-fledged kitchen for the inmates. The existing building is being expanded to accommodate more patients and doctors. The patients have come here from far flung areas including from many places outside the state. The present inmates also include patients suffering from full or partial paralysis, Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's syndrome, Schizophrenia or a combination of above.

Oncolink is providing critical care to those who have none to take care of them, or whose family cannot afford costly domiciliary treatment from traditional establishments. This is a vitally important service, especially in the prevailing disintegrated family situations. As

per the request from Oncolink, our Team Kolkata, on behalf of PRAYAS donated a portable BiPap unit at a total cost of Rs. 54,600.00, to meet a vital need for Oncolink.

A REPORT OF OUR SOCIAL ACTIVITY

Generally we consider that the Police Station and its officials are for to maintain law and order , particularly peace and tranquility in the society, by controlling criminals and crime in the society, but in Howrah we find that the Howrah Women Police Station and its Officials are engaged themselves as the craftsmen to shape the teenagers (from that society which give birth of criminals in the our society) into good citizens in the light of knowledge morality and values, and also to develop their latent talents and to build character. The officers and staff of Howrah Women Police Station have been engaged in such commendable social initiative since 2024 for the welfare of underprivileged and vulnerable children. They are currently taking care of more than seventy students in the age group of 5 to 16 years. These children, many of whom come from extremely poor families, receive free tuition at the police station premises after returning from school. Apart from academic support, the children also participate in creative activities such as drawing, recitation and other co-curricular programmes. Every day, around 60–70 children attend these classes where two teachers provide regular tuition. The police authorities are also ensuring that the children receive nutritious tiffin and dinner, which is a significant support for families living in extreme hardship.

These children with their parents live on footpaths or in nearby bastis, lacking even basic necessities. Considering their condition, the said police officials of Howrah Women Police Station requested the members of PRAYAS to support them by providing them mosquito nets and bed sheets for their families.

As you know we the members of PRAYAS (A joint initiative of CBOA & CBROA) never hesitate to extend our hands beyond boundaries. Responding to that request, PRAYAS arranged for distribution of one mosquito net and one bed sheet to all 71 families.
