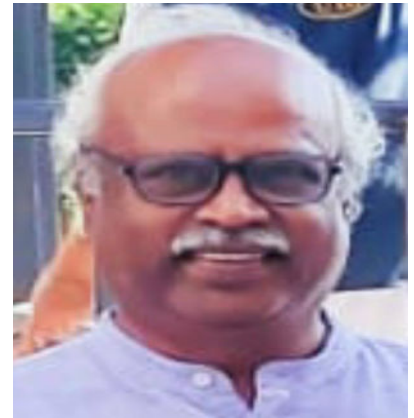
## THE HIDDEN HAND

All move in action; nothing stands still.**

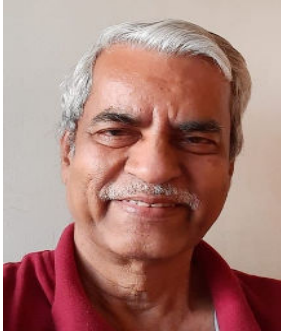

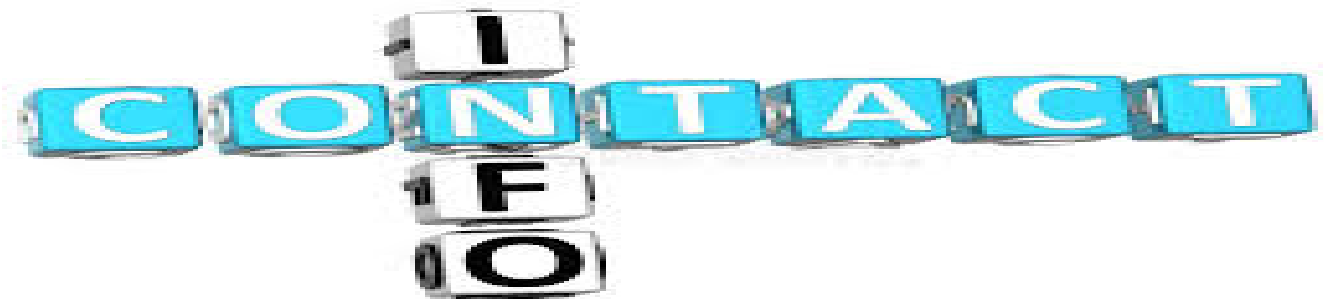
